The name, Nadia, has various meanings. In Russian, it means, simply, hope. In languages with French and Arabic usage, Nadia means tender and delicate. Similarly, the Nadia wines can be defined and understood from various angles and varied perceptions. They convey great complexity and a certain charm.

VARIETALS: 64% Viognier, 29% Grenache Blanc, 7% Roussanne

VINTAGE: 2006

BARREL AGE: 9 Months

BLOCKS: Block O- Planted in 1999 to 8' by 5' vine spacing. Block O is located in the northeast corner of the estate and has the sharpest slope with vines facing directly to the west.

COOPERAGE: Rousseau

BRIX AT HARVEST: 24.1-25.5°

SOILS COMPOSITION: Sandy Loam

ELEVATION: 2800-3600 ft

TRELLISING SYSTEM: Vertical Shoot Positioning (VSP)

ALCOHOL: 14.1%

The NADIA white - think white flowers, apricot, orange blossoms, star jasmine, gardenia buds. These drench the acid note in this wine, resulting in a crispness that is tempered by a honeyed beam of flavor. While many wines are meant to pair with food, the NADIA white can be shared spontaneously, on its own, without a meal. This wine makes you think about all the flavors emerging in the glass.
