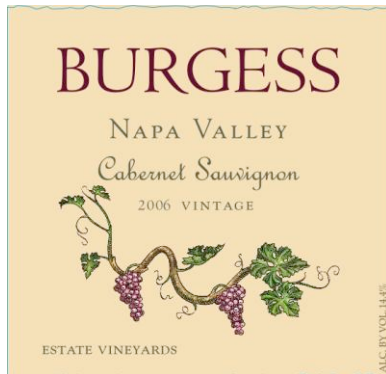




CABERNET SAUVIGNON – Napa Valley

Appellation: Napa Valley, California
Vineyard Locations: Burgess Estate Vineyards, Western & Eastern slopes of Howell Mountain
Grape Variety: 86% Cabernet Sauvignon
8% Cabernet Franc
6% Merlot

Winemaking data: Alcohol 14.5%; pH 3.70; T.A. 0.59;
100% Malolactic Fermentation

Harvest Notes: Our 2006 harvest was quite normal as for its timeliness and quantities. This means that because of these characteristics the results show balance and complexity.

Description:

This wine was produced from grapes grown on the Burgess Cellars' hillside vineyards. One vineyard is on the western-side of Howell Mountain; the other on the eastern-side overlooking Pope Valley. The environment in the two mountain vineyard areas produces grapes of different characteristics. When fruit from both vineyards are blended together they complement each other and create a complex, balanced Cabernet. The vines were replanted in the 70's and 80's and now show a high level of maturity and consistency. We use the most modern fermenters to extract all the positive components and manage tannin extraction.

Winemaker's comments:

The Aromas of this wine are the indications of a unique wine tasting experience. It shows the berry and spice qualities of the Cabernet fruit and then the elegant influence of the French oak barrel aging. The Flavors match what is displayed in the aromas and the lingering finish is the result of mountain grown fruit.
